

# Yellowstone Quilt Fest

## 2019 Block Challenge

### “What’s Blooming in Wyoming”

This year’s Block Challenge subject will showcase the beautiful flora of Wyoming. You are not limited to the “natural flora” but can use fanciful flowers or cultivated flowers if you wish.

#### **RULES:**

Create a 12 1/2" square block (to finish 12" square) expressing the theme. Blocks will not be returned to the maker. They become the property of Yellowstone Quilt Fest and will be used in the next year’s raffle quilt helping to finance the show.

Use only good quality 100% cotton fabric. Any technique or combination of techniques can be used. However, please remember the blocks will be sewn to others and quilted. Allow for 1/4" seams all around.

Limit the use of heavy paints, doodads, fusible, beads, and metallic to types and quantities able to withstand pressing, laundering, and quilting. Fusible materials should be stitched down. Please NO photo transfers, as they don’t hold up under repeated washing.

Pin a paper label on the back with the maker's name, address, and phone number. Do not put the artist's name on the block itself. Artists will be given credit on the back of the finished quilt.

Deliver your block(s) with your quilt entry on Tuesday, Sept 3rd, at the Cody Auditorium from 12:00 to 5:00 pm. Or mail your block(s) to the following address to arrive no later than August 30.
